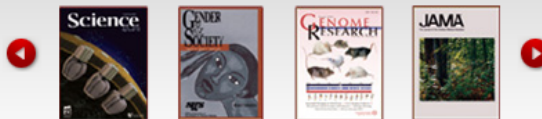

- Alerts on issues, topics, authors, new publications, changes to subscriptions - at your request

INFO, LISTS & LINKS

Many publishers who work with HighWire allow access to their content **without a subscription**. Take a look at a list of publications which offer:

FREE Free full-text content

Titles offering free back issues, trials or entirely free sites

FREE access to developing economies

Titles offering free access to readers in low income countries via optional programs at HighWire, HINARI, AGORA, etc

PPV Pay-per-view access

Titles which offer individual articles or time limited access for a fee

FAQs Publication-specific questions:

Look up URL, ISSN, frequency of publications, DOI prefix numbers, subscription links, and much more

RSS List of publications with RSS feeds:

Subscribe on the publication's website

My Favorites

Customized widget designed to help you keep on top of your favorite titles, providing one-click access to the current issue and instant cross-journal searching to titles you select.



Download to Citation Manager

Easily export abstracts into standard bibliographic management software formats (EndNote, Reference Manager, ProCite, MEDLARS).



Instant Index

From a HighWire portal search, view articles by topic using document clustering software which groups search results into meaningful categories based on the taxonomy of words appearing in the title and abstract.



Keyword in context (KWIC)

Displays the first couple instances of your search terms (from either the full text or the abstract) in each article of a HighWire search result, to help you determine if the article is relevant to your needs.



Citation Map

A picture based view of the reference section of an article, depicts the relationship between the citing and cited articles, indicating the most highly cited.



Matchmaker

An interactive tool that identifies the pattern of main topics within a specific article and suggest matches to other relevant articles hosted on HighWire.



Access at your desktop

When you search for information on HighWire, you can tell at-a-glance if you have access to the full-text of the article, through a personal or institutional subscription, if it's freely available, or offered by pay-per-view.



Topic Map

a Java applet which allows a graphical means to browse topics from content hosted on HighWire. Gives a sense of context while navigating a large, tree-structured database. Opens a separate window.
